Belgian Waffle Recipe: Courtesy of Brock (Danica's husband)

Ingredients

□ 3/4 cup all-purpose flour 1/4 cup cornstarch 1/2 teaspoon salt □ 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon 1/8 teaspoon around nutmea 1/2 teaspoon baking powder 1/4 teaspoon baking soda □ 3/4 cup buttermilk 1/4 cup milk 6 tablespoons vegetable oil

1 large egg separated

1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

1 tablespoon sugar

Instructions

- 1. Pre-heat the oven to 200°F and turn on your waffle iron.
- 2. Mix flour, cornstarch, salt, cinnamon, nutmeg, baking powder, and baking soda in a bowl. In a separate measuring cup, mix together the buttermilk, milk, and vegetable oil, then in the egg yolk. Set aside.
- 3. Beat the egg white to soft peaks, sprinkling in the sugar as you go until the peaks are firm and glossy, then beat in the vanilla.
- Pour the buttermilk mixture into the dry ingredients and whisk until 4 just mixed. Fold the whipped egg white onto the batter in dollops.
- Pour the batter onto the hot waffle iron and cook until crisp and 5. brown. Set cooked waffles in the oven to keep warm.
- 6. Repeat with the remaining batter, holding the waffles in the oven until finished. Once all the waffles are cooked, serve immediately.
